Travel by Foot

Live close to downtown? Save money and avoid the traffic by taking a stroll to the Hispanic Festival. See [walking directions](#) and type in the starting point address.



Travel by Bicycle

Burn off some calories before you hit the fabulous Hispanic Festival food vendors! Ride down and park your bicycle for free. Bicycle parking is also available at the [Government Center ramp](#) (northern Monroe entrance), [Ottawa-Fulton ramp](#) (by the north and south stairwells off Ottawa), or [Monroe Center ramp](#) (entrance off Louis).



Travel by Bus

Roundtrip fare is only \$3.50 plus the Silver Line is free throughout downtown up to the Wealthy Street stops.



Travel by Car

Parking Meters

Monday – Friday: We check meters from 8 am until 5 or 6 pm, Monday through Friday.

Saturdays: You can park free at most meters outside of our enforcement hours unless no parking signs are present. Monroe Center meters are enforced on Saturday.

Sundays: Free parking meters all day.
