Since I am protecting others.

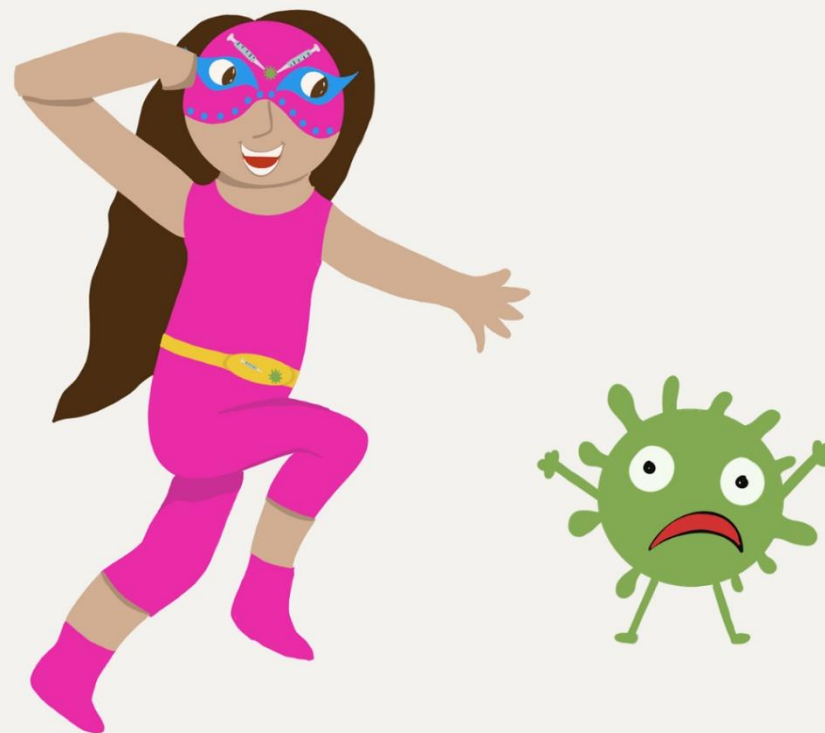


That's correct, Lola! I know that vaccines aren't fun, but they are important!

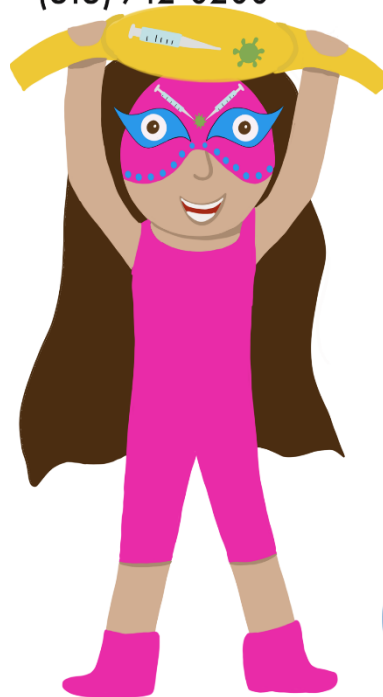
